

**WEST KY IDPA MATCH

THERE WON'T BE ANY "TOTALS" SHOWN IF ANY STAGE SHOWS A "DNF", I USE THE BEST SCORE ON EACH STAGE IF THERE WAS A RESHOOT DONE BY ANYONE, UNLESS A DIFFERENT GUN IS USED FOR THE RESHOOT.

Stage 1: Had 5 strings to it, all beginning as follows: At the signal, draw and fire at one metal plate as quickly as possible, with 1 shot only. A miss counts the same as a miss on an IDPA target. Total shots: 5

Stage 2: At the signal, draw and knock down all 5 plates, strong hand only, Maximum of 12 shots allowed. Any plates left standing will be scored as a miss, the same as on an IDPA target.

Stage 3: From a low ready position, weak hand only, at the signal, draw and knock down all 5 plates, Maximum of 12 shots allowed. Any plates left standing will be scored as a miss, the same as on an IDPA target.

Stage 4: For the first string, start at 30 YARDS away from the pepper popper. At the signal, draw and fire 5 shots at the popper. Each hit counts toward reducing your score. A miss will result in 5 points down.

Stage 5: The same as Stage 4, only this time from 50 yards.

Scoring: -5 for all misses or plates left standing -0 for all hits.

The figure in the () indicates your total "points down" for that stage. This is the scoring of your target hits. Then the total points down are multiplied by .5 and added to your overall time. On any stages reshot, the BEST score obtained was used, whether it was the original score or the reshoot. (Unless new gun used...then that score is shown on the next line so you can compare)
