THERE WON'T BE ANY "TOTALS" SHOWN IF ANY STAGE SHOWS A "DNF", I USE THE BEST SCORE ON EACH STAGE IF THERE WAS A RESHOOT DONE BY ANYONE, UNLESS A DIFFERENT GUN IS USED FOR THE RESHOOT.

Stage 1: 3 Strings from Classifier Stages

- String 1: From the 7 yard line, at signal, draw and fire 2 body shots and 1 head shot to each of the 3 targets, shooting each target as a separate time. LIMITED TO 3 SHOTS ONLY for each target.
- String 2: From the 7 yard line, at signal, from low ready, fire 2 shots to each of the 3 targets with your weak hand only. LIMITED TO A TOTAL OF 6 SHOTS ONLY
- String 3: From the 7 yard line, at signal, draw and fire 2 head shots to each of the 3 targets. LIMITED TO A TOTAL OF 6 SHOTS ONLY.

Stage 2: Out for a Walk

Scenario: As you are out walking in your neighborhood, you see a man and woman walking toward you on the other side of the street, with their large dog. As you get nearer to them, the dog attacks and you find you must draw and fire at least 2 shots into the dog to neutralize. The man draws a knife on you and charges. You must shoot him with at least 2 shots to neutralize as well.

Stage 3: Home Invasion

Scenario: While home watching TV late at night, someone knocks at your front door. Your spouse gets up to see who it is. When they get to the door, 2 people force their way in. You retrieve your gun from the table next to you and shoot each of them at least 2 times to neutralize. BE CAREFUL NOT TO HIT YOUR SPOUSE!!

The figure in the () indicates your total "points down" for that stage. This is the scoring of your target hits. Then the total points down are multiplied by .5 and added to your overall time. On any stages reshot, the BEST score obtained was used, whether it was the original score or the reshoot. (Unless new gun used...then that score is shown on the next line so you can compare)
