THERE WON'T BE ANY "TOTALS" SHOWN IF ANY STAGE SHOWS A "DNF", I USE THE BEST SCORE ON EACH STAGE IF THERE WAS A RESHOOT DONE BY ANYONE, UNLESS A DIFFERENT GUN IS USED FOR THE RESHOOT.

Stage 1: Strings from Classifier Stages

String 1: From the 7 yard line, begin with back to targets and only 6 rounds in your weapon. At signal, turn, draw and fire 2 shots to each of the 3 targets, reload at slide lock and fire 2 more shots to each of the 3 targets. LIMITED TO 4 SHOTS ONLY for each target.

String 2: From the 10 yard line, begin with back to targets and only 6 rounds in your weapon. At signal, turn, draw, and fire 2 shots to each of the 3 targets, reload at slide lock and fire 2 more shots to each of the 3 targets. LIMITED TO 4 SHOTS ONLY for each target.

Stage 2: Parking Lot Attack

Scenario: As you are walking to your car, you are suddenly confronted with 3 attackers. At the signal, draw, seek cover behind the trash can and fire at least 3 shots to each of the 3 targets.

Stage 3: Out to Dinner with Family

Scenario: While you & your family are leaving the restaurant, going to your car, as you near your vehicle, you are ahead of your spouse and child when 3 attackers appear behind them. You yell to "get down" and engage the attackers from behind a large concrete post with at least 3 shots to each. After shooting, you advance to your family, still ready to shoot. As you start to withdraw with your family, the attackers (not dead) re-engage their attack. You will re-engage them as well, with at least 3 more shots to each target. **BE CAREFUL NOT TO HIT YOUR SPOUSE OR CHILD!! (You have a 3 second limit for staying out of cover or a 10 point penalty will be imposed)**

The figure in the () indicates your total "points down" for that stage. This is the scoring of your target hits. Then the total points down are multiplied by .5 and added to your overall time. On any stages reshot, the BEST score obtained was used, whether it was the original score or the reshoot. (Unless new gun used...then that score is shown on the next line so you can compare)
